- National Historic Landmark, considered a Mies van der Rohe masterpiece

- Architecture classrooms and library (Graham Resource Center)

### 16 MM — Materials and Metals Building

- Architecture Materials Lab (space where architecture students learn to use and apply various tools, materials, and techniques)

### 17 KI — Ed Kaplan Family Institute for Innovation and Tech Entrepreneurship

- Innovation hub on campus, with spaces for prototyping, classrooms, workshops, and spaces supporting student applied creativity
- IPro Program (signature team-based project program for all undergraduates)
- Idea Shop (rapid-prototyping lab open to all students)
- Dining: John + Pat Anderson Café

### 18 MC — The McCormick Tribune Campus Center

- Dining: Center Court, Global Grounds (café serving Starbucks coffee and Do-Rite donuts), 7-Eleven

- Entertainment: WIIT radio station, Illinois Tech Bookstore, ping pong tables, lounges

- Mosque

### 26 MH — Machinery Hall

- Like several buildings on campus, has solar panels on its rooftop

### 27 VA — VanderCook College of Music

- All Illinois Tech students can take VanderCook courses

### 28 AL — Auto Lab

- Also known as the Formula SAE Garage, home of IIT Motorsports

### 29 MB — Main Building

- The oldest building on campus, future home of apartments

- Six interconnected halls (North, East, South, Fowler, Grad, Lewis), communal-style living
- Fitness room, laundry, large lounge spaces

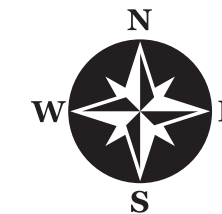
